## Important Dates:

- November 1 - Regular Registration opens for all churches
- January 16 - Church Deposit of \$200 is due - This is Non-Refundable and reserves your church a space at ETC Student Camp 2012
- April 2 - \$40 per camper Deposit is due - This deposit is for all campers, students and adults. This deposit MUST be made for your church to participate in ETC 2012. Deposits are NON-Refundable after May 10, 2012.

### Example:

First Church sends their Church Deposit of \$200 on Dec. 15, 2011 guaranteeing them a space at ETC 2012.

On April 2nd they postmark an envelope sending a check to ETC for 20 camper deposits, a total of \$800.

On May 10 they realize that 2 of their campers are going to move at the end of the school year, so they email a guarantee number of 18 to [steve@exposedtochrist.com](mailto:steve@exposedtochrist.com).

First Church is now responsible for paying for 18 campers at the cost of \$229 per camper, a total of \$4122. Having already paid a total of \$1000, their remaining cost is \$3122.

On May 14 they mail all 18 of their camper forms to ETC.

On June 3 two more students decide to come to camp. Their cost will be \$229 each.

On June 10 First Church comes to UMHB with 20 total campers and a check made out to ETC Ministries for  $\$3122 + \$458 = \$3580$  and they have a great time as the Lord moves in their students and adults!

## **A Word about Dorm Cleanliness and Care**

Every dorm room will be expected to be kept clean and orderly. It is the responsibility of sponsors to encourage campers to clean their dorm. Daily cleaning helps us keep the rooms in good repair, it makes it easier to get away from camp on Thursday, and is required by the staff of the University of Mary Hardin-Baylor.

Also, the camp staff and the dorm staff have master keys to the dorms and will perform spot inspections of rooms. Emphasize to your students that it is against camp rules to move furniture, to remove ceiling tiles, or to otherwise misuse or destroy dorm areas. Students who are found to be in violation of these guidelines may incur charges from the camp administration. All charges will be levied against the sponsoring church. Therefore, we encourage you to closely monitor your student's behavior in the dorm.

We expect the adults to act as mature Christians and to solve any problems in a respectful and honorable manner.

# ETC Youth Camp Rules 2012

**1. Students are not allowed off campus.**

Students must remain ON CAMPUS from the moment of registration on Sunday until check-out on Thursday.

**2. Students are not allowed to ride in or on any vehicle.**

Everyone will walk while attending Youth Camp. There will be no movement of cars, buses, vans, motorcycles, skateboards, roller skates, or roller blades on the campus. All vehicles must be parked in the parking lots from the time of registration on Sunday until load up on Thursday.

**3. Students must attend ALL scheduled activities, including color school times, family group times, recreation, meals, special events, and worship services.**

If your assigned color school or family group is involved in a scheduled activity, whether in the worship center, under a pavilion, or on the athletic field, you must be with them. There are no exceptions to this, unless you are injured or sick and are at the nurse's office.

**4. Students must wear nametags at all times.**

Nametags are required to eat in the cafeteria. Replacement nametags can be obtained from the Camp Director for \$1.

**5. Students who are ill or injured must be in the Youth Camp nurse's office.**

In the event of illness or injury, students will not be permitted to remain in their dorm rooms. Students who are injured or ill will be required to rest in the nurse's office until they are able to return to the regularly scheduled activity or session of their color school or family group.

**6. Students are not allowed to share any medication with any other student.**

ALL medications each student uses or brings with them to Youth Camp are to be listed on their registration forms and given to the

Youth Camp nurse. ALL medications will be dispensed by the Youth Camp nurse.

**7. Students MUST be in the dorm at the time announced each evening.**

Lights out at 11:30 PM. ALL students are required to be in their assigned dorms at the announced time. Your curfew is for your safety and your mental and physical well-being. The daily schedule is very demanding.

# ETC Youth Camp Rules 2012

## 1. Students are not allowed off campus.

Students must remain ON CAMPUS from the moment of registration on Sunday until check-out on Thursday.

## 2. Students are not allowed to ride in or on any vehicle.

Everyone will walk while attending Youth Camp. There will be no movement of cars, buses, vans, motorcycles, skateboards, roller skates, or roller blades on the campus. All vehicles must be parked in the parking lots from the time of registration on Sunday until load up on Thursday.

## 3. Students must attend ALL scheduled activities, including color school times, family group times, recreation, meals, special events, and worship services.

If your assigned color school or family group is involved in a scheduled activity, whether in the worship center, under a pavilion, or on the athletic field, you must be with them. There are no exceptions to this, unless you are injured or sick and are at the nurse's office.

## 4. Students must wear nametags at all times.

Nametags are required to eat in the cafeteria. Replacement nametags can be obtained from the Camp Director for \$1.

## 5. Students who are ill or injured must be in the Youth Camp nurse's office.

In the event of illness or injury, students will not be permitted to remain in their dorm rooms. Students who are injured or ill will be required to rest in the nurse's office until they are able to return to the regularly scheduled activity or session of their color school or family group.

## 6. Students are not allowed to share any medication with any other student.

ALL medications each student uses or brings with them to Youth Camp are to be listed on their registration forms and given to the
