Travel Info:

We will fly from Houston Intercontinental to London Heathrow

This is an overnight flight which means we will leave on Monday and arrive in London on Tuesday.

In London we will travel by subway and train to the High Leigh Conference Center where we will be staying.

While in London we will travel by train, subway and occasionally cab. All group travel is covered.

We will return on Friday, August 3rd, flying from London Heathrow to Houston. We will arrive back in Houston on Friday, August 3rd.

Sight-Seeing:

We will attempt to visit Westminster Abbey, St. Paul's Cathedral, Parliament, The Tower of London, Buckingham Palace, Covent Garden, and more. Keep in mind that some of these require an entry fee of \$10-20. This is in addition to the trip cost.

- prayer walk neighborhoods and venue areas
- serve local churches with whatever outreach they have planned
